*These services will trigger a youth to be in the Measurable Skill Gains & Credential Measures:

(1) WIOA – Tutoring, Study Skills, Training, or Other Instruction, (2) WIOA – Alternative Secondary School Services, (3) WIOA – Dropout Recovery Services, (4) WIOA Training Enrollment, and (5) WIOA-Education.

If the youth should not be in these measures because the WIOA funded service will not lead to a DOL recognized credential, you should enter the Non MSG Training service.

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
